Archie and Bettie were former Missionaries in Mexico, Philippines and Japan. After returning to the States, they felt the call to reach out to Native Americans. In 1996 they came to Arizona.

The purpose of Somebody Cares is to help house and care for Native American children in need.

Somebody Cares also helps bring clothing and food to disadvantaged Native American Families on the Navajo Reservation. Over 10 tons of food and clothing have been distributed to needy families. (along with the "good news of the Gospel")

Although there are so many physical needs on the Reservation- The Lord has been giving us a burden for the children, There are many The children who are left alone in and have had to suffer because of bad choices of the parents. Alcohol and Drugs has even reached the Reservation. In fact some of the young children we have sheltered were tested positive for drugs and alcohol- at birth.

Our number 1 goal is to try and be a blessing to the kids by providing a loving home and family. Our hopes are that the children will get a hunger for Jesus and His Word and accept Him as their Saviour. Praise the Lord all of them have and we have seen such great results and change in the lives of the Children.

Our Needs - Feeling called to this work, we feel we need to Obey. We feel God wants us to open a larger home for more neglected children. There is such a need. So we are making a plea to all to hear the Heart Cry of these kids and partner with us to care for the kids.
